

REPORT OF LOWER LIMB RESURFACING MEDICAL WORKSHOP

The number of road side accidents is increasing day by day due to population explosion and the high number of vehicles and poor condition of roads. This leads to a lot of morbidity and mortality in such trauma victims. These high velocity trauma injuries result in to crush injuries of limbs where the treatment is so difficult that sometime one has to weigh whether to save the life or the limb. These fractures once stabilized require soft tissue envelope later for the proper union and the functional recovery of the patient and here comes the role of plastic surgical procedures to provide the coverage to the fracture. Dr. Pramendra Maheshwari, Organizing Secretary briefed that as per the Indian Orthopaedic Associations president's theme this year Bareilly Orthopaedic Association has decided to Organize a doctor's training workshop on 20th November 2011 Sunday with the title of LOWER LIMB RESURFACING WORKSHOP, in which the experts trained the delegates about the various plastic surgical techniques so that an orthopaedic surgeon in his own hospital setup may plan or can attempt to perform such surgeries.
