Minutes of Executive Committee Meeting UPORTHOCON 25th March 2017(Gorakhpur)

Minutes of Executive committee-UPORTHOCON 2017

Meeting of Executive Committee of UPOA took place in the Hall of Railway Officer's Club Gorakhpur on 25th March 2017

Following were present on the dais.

Obituary: Secretary Dr. Ashish Kumar informed about the sad demise of Dr. S. P. Gupta & Dr. Diwakar Jain (Meerut).

2 minutes silence was observed in remembrance of departed souls.

Confirmation of minutes: Minutes of Executive Meeting of Mid Term Symposium, Jhansi were confirmed.

At the very outset, Dr. Nikunj Kumar enquired about meetings of Constitutional Amendment Committee. Dr. Amit Rastogi, President Elect replied that there were no letters/queries by the members in this regard.

Election Officer's Report: Dr. Amit Rastogi Election Officer presented the report of UPOA Elections for the post of-

1. President Elect- Dr. Atul Srivastava (Agra) unopposed
2. No application for Vice Presidents
3. E.C. members- 3 posts. Following were elected unopposed
 - Dr. Sanjeev Vohra (Agra)
 - Dr. Harendra Chaturvedi (Lucknow)
 - Dr. Ambuj Srivastava (Gorakhpur)

It was decided to discuss in G.B.M for vacant posts of Vice Presidents. Dr. Ashok Vij suggested to go on IOA pattern to have single vice president instead of two and constitutional amendment committee should decide.

Editor's Report: Editor's report was presented by Dr. C.P. Pal (Agra) as Dr. Sanjay Dhawan was out of country.

Dr. Amit Rastogi suggested that U.G.C published the list of journal approved. So we should try to get JBJD enlisted to that and to get indexed with more agencies to further improve its reputation.

Treasurer's Report: Dr. Kaushal Agrawal, Treasurer UPOA presented the report (page No. 20) Dr. Ashok Vij again proposed that 10% of total collection for conferences should be contributed to UPOA on IOA pattern.

It was proposed by treasurer that all office bearers have to provide with their PAN number. Dr. Ashok Vij suggested to add a column for PAN number in Nomination Form

Dr. Kaushal Agarwal further elaborated that PAN number of all city clubs must be provided to UPOA office and audited reports of events must carry the PAN number of club. No temporary PAN number should be used.

He also suggested that brief summary of I. T. R from clubs must be sent to UPOA office.

He also suggested to merge the journal A/C with U.P.O.A to increase Scientific expenses.

Matter of I.T.R deficit was discussed. Dr. Kaushal informed about the progress of that.

Dr. Atul Bahadur Singh suggested to quickly resolve the issue as delay will keep on increasing the interest.

It was also decided unanimously-

-To fix a permanent C.A.

- Incidental changes must be deposited for Journal fund irrespective of savings in conferences. Incidental charges to be raised to Rs. 150/- as per blue book.

- Life Membership fees to be increased to 3000/- instead of 2500/
- Proposal for purchase of a flat for UPOA office at Lucknow - discussed and passed.

Research Grant Committee Report: Dr. Vineet Sharma (chairman) presented that one application by Dr. Vikas Verma was received. Committee, after going through his project, approved for research grant of this year-- Passed.

Gupta, Dr. G.M. Gopal and Dr. S.D. Verma. Two minutes silence was observed in remembrance of departed souls.

Confirmation of minutes: Minutes of Executive Meeting of Mid Term Symposium, Jhansi were confirmed.

Election Officer's Report: Dr. Amit Rastogi Election Officer presented the report of UPOA Elections for the post of-

1. President Elect- Dr. Atul Srivastava (Agra) unopposed
2. No applications for Vice Presidents
3. E.C. members 3 posts- Following were elected unopposed
 - Dr. Sanjeev Vohra (Agra)
 - Dr. Harendra Chaturvedi (Lucknow)
 - Dr. Ambuj Srivastava (Gorakhpur)

For Vice President- names of Dr. Sanjeev Garg (Aligarh) & Dr. Alok Sharma (Ghaziabad) were proposed and seconded by the members & were approved by General Body.

Discussion for the name of Dr. Sanjeev Vohra was discussed regarding approval in absentia.

Dr. Jamal Ashraf commented that postponement of UPORTHOCON creates special condition to consider in absentia.

After discussion Dr. Vohra's name was approved for the post of Executive member.

Treasurer's Report: Dr. Kaushal Agrawal presented the report that is printed on page no. 20

Discussion about C.A was raised. Dr. Ashok Vij (Agra) & Dr. Manoj Mittal (Aligarh) suggested to have regularly paid accountant for 3 years to take care of accounts of UPOA.

Dr. Jamal Ashraf suggested to have fixed office & permanent employees who work for treasurer.

Suggestion was appreciated by the G.B.M to develop a permanent system rather than the individual way of working.

Issue about purchasing a building/ flat (3BHK). UPOA office at Lucknow was raised & passed by G.B.M.

Issue about incidental charges in UPOA events was raised as that has to be deposited for the JBJD fund of UPOA even if there are no savings. It was suggested to make it very clear to the organizers beforehand that there is no way to avoid this.

Dr. Shishir Rastogi (New Delhi) suggested again that on IOA pattern, 10% of total collection should come to UPOA & expenses may be of rest of the money. -Passed.

Dr. Jamal Ashraf suggested that this is only possible once treasurer of UPOA becomes one of the signatories for the event.

Dr. Ashok Vij said that to start with, the same can be done on words of organizing secretary.

Dr. Jamal Ashraf said that numbers of plates for food in conference are 3-4 times as compared to number of registrations. So there should no leniency in this regard. It was passed that organizing secretary must present projected budget & collection in preview meeting before the event.

He also suggested that in PGICL, no faculty should be paid anything as they are teaching their own students, although some members objected, for payment of travel expenses.

Dr. Ashish Kumar requested to General Body to let newly formed Raibareilly club members introduce themselves briefly as they had to leave. Dr. S.M. Singh, Dr. Omkar Singh & Dr. Manish etc. spoke a few words & left.

Dr. Sanjeev Garg proposed for organizing MTS at Aligarh - approved.

Dr. Apoorva Agarwal proposed for UPOA Trauma Course at Ghaziabad –approved

Dr. M.K.S. Sherwani said that PGICL must take place in Medical College. To that, Dr. Jamal Ashraf objected that it is the club with teaching facility & not necessarily the medical college.

Although there was a bid for PGICL to be held at GSVM, Kanpur, but in absentia it was proposed by Dr. Ashok Yadav to be held at Gorakhpur BRD Medical College – passed

UPOA Arthroplasty Course to be held at Lko was proposed by Dr. Uttam Garg – passed.

Problem regarding Dr. Saurabh Agrwal's dates for Ghaziabad National fellowship was discussed. Dr. Jamal Ashraf pointed out some errors in minutes regarding fellowship committee that's why he was unable to co-operate in facilitating this fellowship.

Dr. Ashish Kumar immediately apologized if there was some mistake, it was by him & fellow should not be neglected because of that. Dr. Jamal Ashraf agreed to look in to the matter & soon materializing this issue. Dr. Atul Srivastava, President elect suggested that the fellow may be adjusted this year for the same.

Dr. Jamal Ashraf discussed about his letter written to President, Dr. Saraf regarding Arthroplasty event under aegis of U.P.O.A by Dr. P.K. Shamshery coinciding with UPOA arthroplasty event in the same month. Some hot discussion took place with the President. Dr. K.K. Pruthi intervened and requested both to stay cool.

Letters from Members: Two letters namely by Dr. Sharad Jain (Meerut) & Dr. S.M. Dwivedi (Faizabad) were presented. Both were regarding the selection for Life time achievement award. Process.

Dr. Jamal Proposed that people from outside the state, contributing to U.P.O.A should also be considered for this award. Dr. Dharendra Singh discussed the purpose of this award. Dr. Atul Srivastava & Dr. Jamal Ashraf proposed that every year 2 persons to be chosen, One from U.P & one from outside.

Dr. Jamal Ashraf suggested that instead of past year awardees in selection committee, Past Secretary, Editor & Treasurer should be inducted. Dr. Pruthi proposed that all awards must be given in Valedictory function.

Dr. Dharendra Singh suggested to make it mandatory that all office bearers must be present in G.B.M.

Guidelines to the Organizing Secretaries

(For Academic events organized under the aegis of UP Orthopaedic Association)

1. *Event should be organized under the aegis of the UPOA.*
2. *All members of UPOA shall be informed both by post i.e., Printed Brochure and by electronic media i.e., email or SMS or Facebook or website or Mobile Apps etc. at least 3 weeks prior to the event*
3. *The brochure shall contain apart from the scientific programme and the local organizing committee, the names of the President and Secretary UPOA.*
4. *The President and Secretary UPOA shall be invited well in advance and their travel expenses and stay etc. shall be taken care of by the Loc.*
5. *The seating on the dais shall be as per the blue book i.e., Chief Guest, Guest of Honor, President UPOA, Secretary UPOA, Organizing Chairman, Organizing Secretary, President and Secretary of Local Orthopaedic Club.*
6. *A contribution of Rs 5000 shall be made to the UPOA at the end of the course.*
7. *A brief report with few photographs should be sent to the secretariat within 15 days after completion of the course for record and newsletter.*
8. *Prior information and permission to be sought from the office of the UPOA to ensure the availability of office bearers and that dates don't coincide with other important events of the IOA and UPOA.*
9. *The office bearers and the members of Executive Committee be registered free as per blue book.*
10. *Lighting of lamp at the start of inauguration ceremony and National anthem at the end is mandatory.*
11. *Chief Guest and Guest of Honor preferably be eminent medical personalities. Avoid politicians.*
12. *Inauguration ceremony should not be more than 30min*
13. *Certificates do have logo of UPOA and Local Orthopaedic Club and signed by President and Secretary UPOA, President and Secretary Loc, Org. Chairman and Org. Secretary.*
14. *Banner should have logo of UPOA and with the mention 'organized under the aegis of UPOA'.*
15. *The Organizing Secretary should be present in the inaugural function of the subsequent annual conference, the UPORTHOCON, to receive the award of appreciation.*
16. *Faculty selection should encourage members of UPOA, at least 50% from the state.*
17. *Apply for MCI accreditation points.*
18. *Rest of the instructions to be followed as per UPOA Blue Book.*

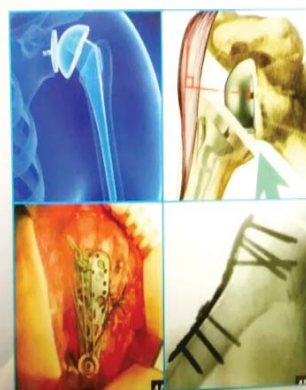

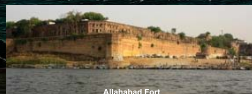

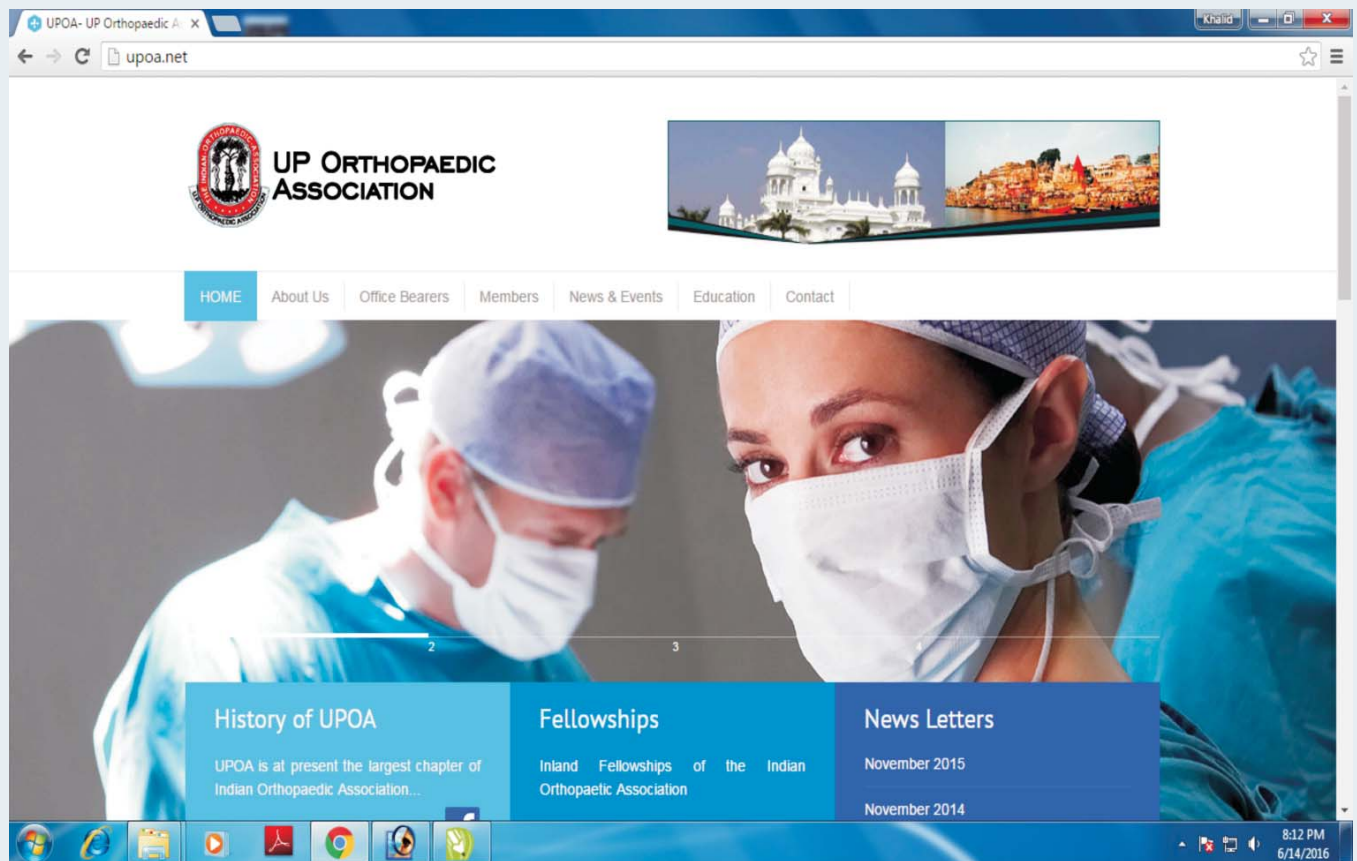
