

Mid Term Symposium, Aligarh Executive Committee Meeting 24- September 2017

Minutes of Executive committee Meeting held at MTS at Aligarh on 24 September 2017

Obituary: Dr. K.P Srivastava was remembered. Dr. Sanjay Dhawan praised him for his sporting & calm behavior, his excellent teaching. Dr. Dhirendra Singh also spoke about his greatness.

2 minutes silence was observed in rememberance of departed soul.

Confirmation of minutes: Minutes of ECM & GBM of UPORTHOCON 2017, Gorakhpur were confirmed. Fellowship report: Dr. Dhirendra Singh, Chairman Fellowship Committee informed that he has submitted the report to secretary. Dr. Ashish Kumar detailed the names of fellows. He apprised the house that two seats of UPOA visiting and UPOA travelling were not availed yet. House consented for allotting those vacant ones by fellows selected by Secretary & President. Dr. Ashish informed the house about that many applications for fellowships were found to be ineligible as per the rules by looking in to the list of fellows in the last 5 years.

Dr. Ashok Gupta (Ghaziabad) informed that last year, Ghaziabad international fellowship was not availed by anyone probably couldn't be arranged overseas. He also raised the issue that fellowship report is not being sent to Ghaziabad Club.

Dr. Ashok was informed about the reason & assurance that from here onwards Ghaziabad club will receive reports. Dr. Atul said that one who couldn't avail last year, will be sent this year.

Dr. Ashok Gupta further added to make a waiting list of fellows for these fellowships to ensure that fellowships are availed. He also advised that other members, especially from Medical College must utilize their overseas contacts to arrange for fellowships. Dr. Atul, President Elect reminded that it has been passed that fellows not going for fellowship after allotment, must be debarred for any $UPO\Lambda$ fellowship in future.

Members discussed about fellows altering the dates repeatedly that was condemned unanimously unless there was some very genuine reason. Dr. Gyaneshwar Tonk advised to decide the dates after consultation with the fellows.

Dr. Dhirendra Singh wished to get relieved from his responsibility as Chairman, but house requested him to continue.

Dr. C.P Pal requested that International fellowship should not be restricted because of availing two fellowships. House accepted that International fellowships are spared but can only be availed once by any member.

Treasurer's report: Dr. Kaushal Agarwal presented the report (Page no. 10). He informed the Dr. Ambuj has sent him the details of UPORTOCON. Dr. Ashish informed that he had the informed that 8 lacs deficit has been shown in balance sheet. He also informed that despite of many reminders he has not submitted the audited report probably because of his health issues.

 Λ lot of discussion went on. Dr. Ashish informed that like IOA, depositing 10% of all collection has already been decided in last GBM & circulated in UPOA Times.

Dr. Tonk raised the issue of G.S.T. Dr. Ashok Gupta said that 10% after deducting the G.S.T from total collection should be deposited. Dr. Ashish Kumar advised to reduce expenditure of conference as well as that of association. He once again suggested for electronic newsletter. Dr. Nikunj suggested electronic souvenir of conference as well. Proposal was appreciated by all.

Treasurer raised the issue of incidental charges. He informed that the same of MTS Jhansi had not been received yet.

Dr. Atul suggested to send a letter in this regard.

Repeatedly members pressed upon deposition of 10% of collection at the time of pre-conference visit.

Dr. Dhirendra Singh suggested that the whole city club must be made responsible for this kind of act of irresponsibility by Dr. Ambuj, Gorakhpur. Some members suggested for security amount at the time of allotment, but found to be impractical by the house.

Dr. Saraf suggested that 1 week before 10% of the collection must be taken.

Dr. Dhirendra Singh emphasized for letter of condemnation to Gorakhpur & Jhansi. It was passed by house that not submitting audited report within 6 months of conference is financial irregularly & we must make some rule so that this should not happen in future.

It was decided to present in G.B.M once again to finalize 10% of total collection to Association at the time of pre-conference visit & 1 week before the conference & finally with the audited report.

Treasurer informed that one Fixed Deposit was encashed to meet out the expenses. Income tax matter was discussed and house was apprised by the status by treasurer.

Dr. Amit Rastogi, President, appreciated the hard work of Dr. Kaushal Agarwal with a big hand of applause by the house.

It was again discussed that charitable organization must spend 85% of income to avail income tax rebate Dr. Kaushal apprised that this year we had less income & more expenses so not much of tax liabilities. He informed that all problem is because of previous outstanding.

Editor's report: Dr. Sanjay Dhawan informed the details that 2nd April 2016 onwards, there are 40 + articles, from overseas as well. He informed that Indian Orthopaedic Research group is our Editorial support partner & JBJD is indexed from 2017 December & now the first edition also indexed (ICE value of 72.6). Till date there is credit of Rs. 58485/-and debit of 47761/- (balance 10724/-). Expenditure of this issue is 220,000 & contribution 147000 from Torrent is awaited. He emphasized to ensure incidental charges at least. He informed that presently there are two issues, to be extended for 3 issues/year as more funds will be available. He informed that besides present indexing with Copernicus, 2-3 more have been applied.

Dr. Atul appreciated the hard work of editor & his team. He congratulated and informed the house that no money has been taken from UPO Λ for Journal Expenses.

Letters from members: Dr. Ashish informed that no letters were received. He apprised about two emails by Dr. S.C Goel & Dr. A.N Verma about marking system abolition in deciding Life time achievement award.

UPORTHOCON 2018: Program Report- Dr. Anuj Gupta informed about the progress. He informed about meeting of club had staken place few days back after Arthroscopy meeting at Allahabad. He informed that Allahabad club account will be frozen till UPORTHOCON transaction is over with the same account. He informed that 18% G.S.T has to be taken on registrations & a registration fees itself has also been raised. He further informed that

He informed that Dr. Anil Gupta Memorial Lecture to be delivered by some speaker from China. Travel expenses to every foreign faculty will be given only Domestic Airfare. Dr. Atul Srivastava informed about speakers of various orations for UPORTHOCON 2018. Only name of Dr. Abbas Ali Khan Memorial Lecture is yet to be decided.

Dr. Amit Rastogi discussed the mails by Dr. S.C Goel & Dr. A.N Verma regarding Life time achievement award. He explained that marking system was passed after being proposal by constitutional amendment committee so it still prevails.

He proposed that the matter will be sent to constitutional amendment committee to think & decide to have two Life time achievement award from this year onwards. One for Past Presidents & one for other members to be marked as before. Dr. Sanjay Dhawan commented that there are falcies in marking criteria- for example there is no place for organizing chairman of the conference, only the org. secretary gets the marks. He suggested to review & amendthe rules. it was seconded by Dr. Nikunj Agarwal. It was approved by the house to have two Life time achievement awards. Dr. Ashish Kumar apprised that 3 names have been proposed by City clubs for this award. It was decided that the two names will be announced only after constitutional amendment committee meeting and being approved by G.B.M. So it was decided be present Life time achievement award in Valedictory function & not in Inaugural function.

Once again matter of UPORTHOCON 18 was discussed Dr. Ashish expressed his apprehension about attendance in conference with one day pre-conference CME & 5 workshops.

Dr. Amit & Dr. Atul also had some apprehensions. Dr. Ashish advised to attribute the conference itself to Prof. S.C Gaur rather than having one day more for CME or some other event may be organized and attributed to Dr. S.C Gaur.

Dr. Atul suggested to catch hold of medical colleges for PG's to attend workshops. Suggestions were given to improve the quality & quantity of audience. Dr. Tonk also had the some apprehension and raised the concern about PG's also not attending.

Dr. Dhawan advised that certificate must be given at the end of conference & not before. Meeting ended with vote of thanks to the chair.

Guidelines to the Organizing Secretaries

(For Academic events organized under the aegis of UP Orthopaedic Association)

- 1. Event should be organized under the aegis of the UPOA.
- 2. All members of UPOA shall be informed both by post i.e., Printed Brochure and by electronic media i.e., email or SMS or Facebook or website or Mobile Apps etc. at least 3 weeks prior to the event
- 3. The brochure shall contain apart from the scientific programme and the local organizing committee, the names of the President and Secretary UPOA.
- 4. The President and Secretary UPOA shall be invited well in advance and their travel expenses and stay etc. shall be taken care of by the Loc.
- 5. The seating on the dais shall be as per the blue book i.e., Chief Guest, Guest of Honor, President UPOA, Secretary UPOA, Organizing Chairman, Organizing Secretary, President and Secretary of Local Orthopaedic Club.
- 6. A contribution of Rs 5000 shall be made to the UPOA at the end of the course.
- 7. A brief report with few photographs should be sent to the secretariat within 15 days after completion of the course for record and newsletter.
- 8. Prior information and permission to be sought from the office of the UPOA to ensure the availability of office bearers and that dates don't coincide with other important events of the IOA and UPOA.
- 9. The office bearers and the members of Executive Committee be registered free as per blue book.
- 10. Lighting of lamp at the start of inauguration ceremony and National anthem at the end is mandatory.
- 11. Chief Guest and Guest of Honor preferably be eminent medical personalities. Avoid politicians.
- 12. Inauguration ceremony should not be more than 30min
- 13. Certificates do have logo of UPOA and Local Orthopaedic Club and signed by President and Secretary UPOA, President and Secretary Loc, Org. Chairman and Org. Secretary.
- 14. Banner should have logo of UPOA and with the mention 'organized under the aegis of UPOA'.
- 15. The Organizing Secretary should be present in the inaugural function of the subsequent annual conference, the UPORTHOCON, to receive the award of appreciation.
- 16. Faculty selection should encourage members of UPOA, at least 50% from the state.
- 17. Apply for MCI accreditation points.
- 18. Rest of the instructions to be followed as per UPOA Blue Book.


